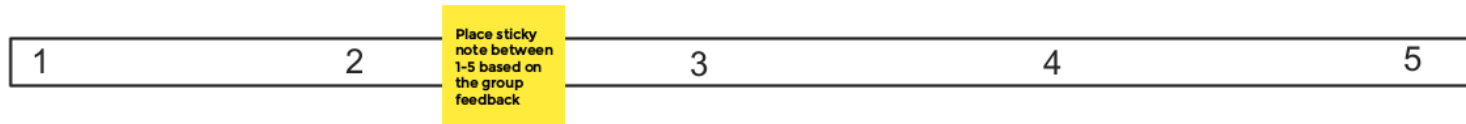


Room 2: Participation Revolution
