
Room 6: Policies and Standards

Coaltions of NGOs, larger organisations, Dochas, etc. need to coordinate to deliver strong messaging to donors.

Level of bureaucracy needs to be reduced; we need to collectively advocate for this. When we represent our work to main donors, we need to present cohesive messaging. 'We won't take that kind of funding as it's too restrictive of localisation'.

Creation of a standard by which localisation is measured and encouraged. What are the areas they would like to take forward (Collectively)

How can we change the amount of money being directed to local NGOs? How can we play a role in this? What would be a reasonable target number?

What is our messaging as Dochas members regarding locally led development? Is there a better way to communicate this as a priority?
